Introduction:

CIRG contribute in the NAIP (C-3) project as one of the consortia partners with leadership at HAU Hisar. Having total budget of 15.5 lakhs for 4 years (2009-13)

Objective:

To work for improving the livelihood security of poor and resource less farmers of Mewat region of Haryana through intervention of goat rearing practices developed at CIRG, Makhdoom..

Salient Achievements:

During 2009-10, as per the technical programme, total 50 farmer’s families from 5 villages were identified and selected in Cluster II of Mewat for goat rearing interventions. Each selected farmer family of the selected villages was given 3 goats. Thus a total of 30 goats along with 2 bucks were distributed in each selected village. A total of 150 goats and 11 bucks were distributed in 5 villages. The animals given were vaccinated against PPR and Enterotoxaemia disease before distribution. They were also drenched with anthelmintics.

In 2010-11, the technical programme of CIRG includes providing of feed, mineral mixture and medicinal treatment along with recording of data on production and reproductive performance, training for value added product and market analysis.
