ICAR- Central Institute for Research on Goats, Makhdoom celebrated its 38th Foundation day here today.



Dr. S.M.K Naqvi, ICAR- Central Sheep and Wool Research Institute, Avikanagar (Rajasthan) in his foundation day lecture highlighted the role of small ruminants especially goats in the livelihood and nutritional security of the resource poor farmers of the country.

Dr M S Chauhan, Director, ICAR-CIRG appraised about the recent achievements and activities of the institute. He also elaborated the need of low cost implementable technologies for the goat rearing that can be adopted by the goat farmers. He stressed that low cost implementable technologies is going to double the goat farmer's income by 2022.
