

ISSGPU-Fellow Award

Dr. M.K. Singh, ARS, Principal Scientist in the discipline of Animal Genetics and Breeding has been awarded ISSGPU Fellow for outstanding contribution in research and dissemination of production technologies. He has established more than “30 multiplier flocks of Barbari breed” through which road map has been created for effective utilization, genetic improvement and conservation of Barbari goat and development of goat based agri-business and integrated livelihood models. These innovations have resulted in promoting scientific goat farming in farmers flock, goat based entrepreneurship development among educated youth and doubling farmers’ income. He has acted as resource person in policy formulation for goat breed improvement and development for Uttar Pradesh, Utrakhand, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, North-Eastern states and Goa. He is a recipient of the “Best Extension Professional Award” by the Society of Extension Education in 2017. He has to his credit more than 160 publications.
