BIODATA

Dr Dinesh Kumar Sharma is a veterinary science graduate from Mathura Veterinary College (CSAU Kanpur) of 1984 batch. He completed his postgraduate and doctorate degrees in Veterinary Parasitology in 1986 and 1995, respectively. After about two and half years of tenure in the Madhya Pradesh State Government as a Veterinary Surgeon, he joined Agriculture Research Services in 1989 in 32nd FOCARS batch at NAARM Hyderabad. He has accomplished research work in the field of veterinary helminthology, parasites epidemiology, Host-Parasite Interaction, parasitic disease resistance and anthelmintic resistance. In more than 30 years of his research career, Dr Sharma has worked as a Scientist, Senior and Principal Scientist and completed more than 13 institute projects and 4 externally funded research projects of the various agencies like NATP, NAIP, DST and DBT and guided 6 postgraduate and 3 PhD students for their research. In 2012, he visited the US and had training on Newer Advanced Parasitological Techniques at Wisconsin University Madison in Pathobiology Laboratory with Professor Yoshino Timothy. Dr Sharma has been on faculty members' list of Deemed University ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar and DUVASU, Mathura and worked as examiner and paper setter for various courses. He published more than 60 research papers in international and national journals of repute and authored 3 books, 12 bulletins and folders along with large numbers of technical and scientific chapters in various books and Training manuals both in English and Hindi. Dr Sharma has been bestowed with **RAJBHASHA GAURAV AWARD** by the President of India for his Hindi book ***Bakri-Bhed Rog: Chikitsa Evam Prabandhan*** in 1996.
